The Agriculture and Extension Education Committee met on September 8, 2010. Dean Johansen, Agriculture and Extension Education Committee Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:15 pm.

Approve Agenda. Motion by Brown; seconded by Jepsen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Public Comments. No public comments.

<u>Minutes of Last Meeting.</u> Motion by Jepsen; seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes from the August 11, 2010 meeting. Motion carried.

<u>Dog Claims.</u> Roger Harms, resident of the town of Clayton, requested reimbursement for the death of three male deer. (At this point, Chair Johansen, left). Jepsen made a motion to offer \$1000; seconded by Johnson. Mr. Harms announced he was going to get a lawyer and left the meeting. Jepsen's motion was not voted on. Without objection by the two remaining committee members (Rattel and Brown), the motion and second were withdrawn. Jepsen made a motion to deny the claim of Mr. Harms; Johnson seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

<u>2011 Budget.</u> A copy of the most current budget was distributed highlighting the 1.5% levy reduction from UW Extension 2010 budget.
