The Land Conservation Committee met August 10, 2011 in the County Board Room.

Chairman Johansen called meeting to order at 9:39. Motion (Jepsen/Johnson) to approve the agenda. Motion (Rattel/ Brown) to approve the July minutes. Both motions carried unanimously.

Public Comment. None

Wildlife Damage. Revocation of Wildlife Damage Program participation

In absence of Cindy Blonk, Ritten presented information regarding a deer damage shooting permit for an individual who purchased a farm with wildlife damage history on Burnett/Polk line. This person was given time and information by DNR personnel on the proper procedure for registering and processing deer and failed to follow procedure. Motion (Brown/Johansen) to revoke Walter Den Hoed enrollment in the Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program for the 2011 and 2012 program years and request the District Attorney's Office to consider ten additional years. Motion carried.

<u>Budget Review – Review 2012 LWRD Budget</u> – Ritten reviewed changes for LWRD department 2012 budget. Reduction in levy with employee's retirement contributions. Discussed the increase in revenues with pending grant from Cedar Lake.

Voucher Review. Burkhardt handed out the voucher report for committee members to review.

Director's Report.

- Citation was issued by Sheriff Deputy for aquatic vegetation on boat trailer
- Under the Stormwater/Erosion Control Ordinance an "after the fact" permit application was received for a business in the Town of Apple River
- Under the Animal Waste Ordinance, the LWRED checked out a call regarding a possible storage facility being constructed w/o a permit, which was found to be false. The department also found a failed manure storage facility in the Town of Laketown that now is being properly designed.
- Both Katelin and Jeremy were on WPCA radio for a 20 minute radio show last week.
- Twin cities news had a report on a lake that plans to install a gate across the access. The gate requires a free token from a boat cleaner/inspection area a few miles away in order for the gate to open to launch a boat. "Restricted Lake Access" by Channel 4 reporter Bill Hudson on July 25, 2011.

- Polk County Association of Lakes and Rivers meeting was July 20. They elected officers. Karen Engelbretson is president for one more term, Jim Maxwell from Blake Lake is treasurer, Katelin is secretary (to take notes)
- LWRD are working with West Central Region DNR staff on a grant to study phosphorus runoff from fields draining to Cedar Lake and are continuing to pursue a grant to study toxic blue/green algae in Long Lake.
