

Polk County Property, Forestry and Recreation Committee – May 3, 2010

The Polk County Property, Forestry and Recreation Committee met in the County Board Room of the Polk County Government Center.

Members present: Larry Jepsen, Neil L Johnson, William Johnson IV, Ken Sample, Diane Stoneking

Meeting called to order at 2:30 p.m. by County Board Chairman William Johnson IV.

Election of Officers: Chairman Johnson opened nominations for Chair. Supervisor Stoneking nominated Supervisor Ken Sample, Supervisor Wm. Johnson nominated Supervisor Larry Jepsen. **Motion (N.Johnson/Sample) to close nominations for Chairman. Vote: Sample – 2, Jepsen – 3.** Jepsen elected as Chairman of the committee.

Chairman Jepsen opened nominations for Vice-Chair. Supervisor Sample nominated Supervisor Diane Stoneking, Supervisor Stoneking nominated Supervisor Ken Sample. **Motion (N.Johnson/Wm Johnson) to close nominations for Vice-Chair.** A unanimous vote was cast for Supervisor Stoneking for Vice-Chair.

Chairman Jepsen requested nominations for Secretary. Supervisor N.Johnson nominated Supervisor Ken Sample, Supervisor Sample nominated Supervisor Neil Johnson. **Motion (Wm Johnson/Sample) to close nominations for Secretary.** A unanimous vote was cast for Supervisor Neil Johnson for Secretary.

The committee unanimously decided to set the regular meeting schedule as the first Monday of the month at 1:30 p.m. with the next meeting being set for Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup>.

Motion (Sample/Johnson) to approve the amended agenda. Motion carried by voice vote.

Motion (Stoneking/Wm Johnson) to approve the minutes from the April 5, 2010 meeting. Motion carried by voice vote.

No public comments.

Director Debbie Peterson introduced the committee to Polk County's new forester, Jeremy Koslowski. Koslowski reviewed the 2009 annual report as prepared by 2009 Forest Administrator Paul Pedersen.

Motion (Wm. Johnson/N.Johnson) to approve the 2009 Forestry annual report and pass it on to the full county board. Motion carried by voice vote.

Koslowski distributed and reviewed his activity report.

DNR Forester Paul Heimstead distributed the agenda for the 2010 WCFA Summer Tour and reviewed tour which is scheduled for Burnett and Polk Counties June 16-18. Heimstead also gave a short orientation of the forestry program to the new committee members.

Register of Deeds Laurie Anderson discussed flat fee increase/social security redaction legislative change and updated the committee on office activities.

Treasurer Amanda Nissen addressed the committee concerning a tax foreclosure request. Mr. David Jertson d.b.a. The Wild Card Steakhouse & Saloon Inc. addressed the committee.

Motion (Wm Johnson/Stoneking) to offer a 6-month extension on the foreclosure process to David Jertson d.b.a. The Wild Card Steakhouse & Saloon Inc. on Town of Beaver parcel #008-00884-0100. Motion carried by voice vote.

Nissen distributed information on the managed forest program property in the Town of McKinley taken through tax deed. The county conducted a timber sale on the property. Nissen will bring back the issue of selling this property to the committee at the June meeting.

Nissen will advertise for sale by sealed bid the .79 acre parcel #020-00417-0000 in the Town of Eureka with the bids due by 1:30 p.m. June 7, 2010.

Nissen updated the committee on the 2006 tax foreclosures and the tax foreclosure process.

Nissen distributed information regarding Ficek Investment Company, Inc. property in the City of St Croix Falls which has unpaid taxes and special assessments due from 2007 and 2008. Corporation Counsel Jeff Fuge discussed and recommended the option to collect money being held by the City of St Croix Falls for unpaid taxes and special assessments.

Motion (N.Johnson/Sample) to move forward with a resolution to recover money being held by the City of St Croix Falls for unpaid taxes and special assessments on parcel #281-01397-0000. Motion carried by voice vote.

Koslowski discussed his attendance, along with D. Peterson and Supervisor Jepsen's attendance at the NoRTAC meeting in Hayward. He also discussed the UTV pilot program the DNR conducted and the expanded second pilot program requiring each county to pass a resolution permitting UTV use on trails within their county.

Motion (Sample/Wm Johnson) to draft a resolution and a presentation to send to the full county board for approval to participate in the 2010-2012 Wisconsin Utility Terrain Vehicle Pilot Program. Motion carried by voice vote.

Highway Commissioner Steve Warndahl addressed the committee. He updated the new committee on improvements that have been made to the highway shop in 2009.

Motion (Stoneking/Sample) to go into closed session pursuant to WI § 19.85(1)(e) to develop bargaining and negotiating strategies that the Committee may recommend with regards to the purchase of public lands made through a competitive basis and open discussion would compromise the county's bargaining position with regards to the prospective purchase of such public lands. Wm Johnson – yes, N. Johnson – yes, Stoneking – yes, Sample – yes, Jepsen – yes. Motion carried. The committee went into closed session at 4:00 p.m. Present during the closed session were the five committee members plus Steve Warndahl, Debbie Peterson and Jeff Fuge.

Motion (Wm Johnson/Stoneking) to return to open session. Wm Johnson – yes, N. Johnson – yes, Stoneking – yes, Sample – yes, Jepsen – yes. Motion carried. The committee returned to open session at 4:20 p.m.

Peterson reported on the Earth Day celebration at the recycling center. She contacted the DOT concerning the buildings across the street from the recycling center that need to be removed. She asked the committee for permission to investigate associated costs for moving the two buildings.

Motion (Sample/Stoneking) to authorized Peterson to look into the options to move the two

Fair Secretary Gerrianne Christiansen addressed the committee. She distributed the 2010 Fair budget and a timeline for the long-range plan for Polk County Fair Park.
