Steve Moe gave the Sheriffs report. The law enforcement budget is down about 2%. The fee schedule was presented. The average daily jail population in July was 92. Twenty four hours of training a year is required. Much is done in house.

Jeff Fuge discussed the Corp Council/Child Support budget. This showed a reduction of 2%. Also discussed was the position of Child Support Lead Worker. Themonthly cash flow analysis for Child Support was presented. Mr. Fuge is asking for additional levy for the lead worker position.
