Medical Examiner John B. Dinnies – discussed total cases and four fatalities – statistically equal for four years. Discussed handout.

Sheriff Pete Johnson – has no official items. New cars are being built and detailed. Old cars are going to sale on 10/13. Deputy Birr has gone full time effective 9/2/12. Tamara Larson is back as part time deputy. Currently looking for one additional part time deputy.

Child Support Agency Malia Malone - budget is looking good. They are waiting for final numbers from the state. Preliminary strategic plan should be ready for next meeting in October.

District Attorney Dan Steffen – Covering August numbers. Bond forfeiture has taken place – will ask for it as a budget item for drug court as budget request as they would get matching grant. Want to purchase SCRAM units – detects alcohol via skin surface – are \$1,500 each. Would like to have felony participation or non-violent criminal whose drug of choice is alcohol in lieu of

cash bond or in addition to cash bond. Is a possible county board item for consideration.
