PUBLIC PROTECTION Tuesday September 7, 2010

Chairman Luke Called the meeting to order at 2 P.M.

Motion O Connell/Edgell to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion Edgell/Luke to approve August minutes. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Jess Mattocks voiced his concern over problems in his neighborhood.

County Administrator Dana Frey brought the committee up to date on the budget process. The committee was asked to look over the budgets of District Attorney/ Victim Witness Office, Office of Medical Examiner, Clerk of Court, Sheriffs Department and Child Support Agency.

County Nurse Gretchen Sampson spoke on the smoking ban. Consensus to have a public hearing.

Medical Examiner Jonn Dinnes reported 22 cases for August. Three accidents, one motorcycle fatality and two suicides. 186 cases this year, same as last year.

Lois Hoff, Clerk of Court, reported that new rules concerning restraining orders became effective September 1, 2010.

Sheriff Moore reported that 307 personnel hours were used at the fair at a cost of \$9154. No problems at the fair. A new Deputy will go to work September 23. An inmate was at Golden Age Manor for 11 days. Cost to guard him was \$6000.

Jeff Fuge said the presentation, There Goes My Life, is being held through out the area. He asked for a three month extension of a part time employee. Motion Edgell/Luke to transfer money from two lines to pay for this position \$5925. Motion carried.

Motion Edgell/Luke to adjourn at 4.12. Carried.
